Action verbs in simple present. Basic commands.

Simple Present

Subject + verb in the base form/third person(-s)

Example:

You need a notebook, a pencil and crayons.

She draws a table.

Basic commands

A command is to give someone an order.

To form a command, the sentence must begin with the base form of the verb.

Example:

Draw a ball under the table.

Color the shoes with brown crayon.

Circle the apple with yellow crayon.

Write your name and **underline** it.
