### TEACHING-LEARNING ACTIVITIES

- **Activation**
  - Conduct a quick review of clothing vocabulary with picture flashcards.
  - Pronounce each word clearly and have students repeat after you.
  - Display the following words: shorts, t-shirt, pants, jeans, sweater, coat, blouse, red, yellow, green, orange, white, black.
  - Ask students to repeat each word, emphasizing correct pronunciation.
- **Construction**
  - Introduce a tongue twister activity to practice pronunciation.
  - Start at a normal speed and gradually increase the speed.
  - Have students repeat the tongue twisters, focusing on clear pronunciation.
  - Encourage repetition at a faster pace once students are comfortable.
- **Application**
  - Engage students in a riddle's activity using vocabulary words.
  - Provide examples such as: "I'm a cozy piece, worn on cold days, over a t-shirt, in many ways. What am I?" (Answer: Sweater)
  - Allow students to solve riddles related to clothing vocabulary.
  - For example: "I cover your legs, from waist to feet, not a skirt, it's snug and neat. What am I?" (Answer: Pants)
  - Encourage participation and correct answers.
- **Practice**
  - Assign students a task to create five sentences using the vocabulary and expressions learned.
  - Example sentences: "I am wearing a red sweater." or "I usually wear a coat in winter, but today I am wearing a t-shirt."
  - Instruct students to record their sentences, save the file, and send it to the teacher for evaluation.
  - **Adjust the difficulty level of the riddles and sentences based on the students' proficiency.**
