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TEACHING – LEARNING ACTIVITIES

- **Activation**
 - Show some images related to these phrases: *I would like to go to Galapagos Islands, I plan to travel to other country next year, I want get a scholarship when I graduate, I mean that I am going to take French lessons, I hope to meet new friends, I expect to improve my English skills.* Ask students to pay close attention and listen to the pronunciation of the sentences.
 - Tell students they are going to hear an audio resource that will encourage them to practice vocabulary and pronunciation. (*audio resource*)
- **Construction**
 - Share about your future plans for the next holiday in your country. Use the future tense with be + going to. Write some of them on the board and ask students to read.
 - Ask students to think about their future plans for the next holiday. Ask questions, such as: where are you going to go? When are you going to go? What are you going to do? Who are you going to go with? How are you going to go?
 - Pair students up in the classroom. Encourage them to share the ideas about their future plans. Ask the pairs to switch roles and repeat the process.
- **Application**
 - Ask students to create a conversation about their future plans for the next holiday. Ask students to include expressions learned in class, for example: I would like.. I plan... I want..., I mean... I hope..., I expect... and future tense.
 - Encourage students to present their conversation in front of the class.
- **Vocabulary**
 - Verbs and expressions:
 - Would like: Used to say that you want something or want to do something.
 - Plan: Something you have decided to do.
 - Want: To have a desire for something
 - Mean: To express or represent something such as an idea, thought, or fact.
 - Hope: To want something to happen or be true and to believe that it is possible.
 - Expect: To think that something will happen because it seems likely or has been planned.
 - Action verb: A verb that expresses action.

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- **Grammar**

Future tenses to express future plans.

Use “be+ going to” to talk about plans or intentions:

Subject + form of “to be” (am/is/are) + going to + base of a verb

Examples:

He is going to work in a volunteer program with local people.

He is going to feed animals.

He is going to help to take care of rescued animals at a wildlife center in the Amazon Jungle.
