

The modal verb "should" is commonly used to express advice, recommendations or suggestions.

Affirmative Form:

Subject + should + base form of the verb

Examples:

- Families should celebrate festivals together.

Negative Form:

Subject + should not (shouldn't) + base form of the verb

Examples:

- They shouldn't travel by bus at night.

Question Form:

Should + subject + base form of the verb?

Examples:

- Should we start the survey today?
