Simple Present Tense:

Offering Help:

Structure:

Subject + verb in the base form + offer word/ helping verb + object

Use present tense verbs (base form) with subjects (I, you, we, they) and "he, she, it."

Add an offer word or a helping verb to make it polite.

Examples:

- Can I help you carry those boxes?
- Do you need help with your homework
- I am happy to help you with your homework.

Self-Assessment:

Structure:

Subject + verb in the base form + adverb /adjective + to be + self-assessment

Use present tense verbs with subjects. Add an adverb or adjective to describe the action. Use "to be" (am, is, are) with a self-assessment.

Examples:

- I am always willing to help my friends.
- She is happy to help with the school project.
- We are ready to help whenever needed.
