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TEACHING-LEARNING ACTIVITIES

Activation

- Start a conversation with students about the activities they can participate in after school and the benefits of doing so.
- o Discuss all the places they can go for these activities.
- o Facilitate a creative brainstorming session on the board based on the discussion.
- o Introduce the characters from the dialogue (Julia and Robert).
- o Play the audio of the dialogue, making sure to replay it as needed.
 - What activity did Robert join after school?
 - What did Julia do after school?
 - What tips has Eugenia shared with Julia about after-school activities?
 - The teacher can ask some other questions related to the level and interest of the students.

Construction

- In small groups, have students write about the after-school activities they have participated in, incorporating the vocabulary from the brainstorming session.
- Encourage discussion and collaboration among group members.
- o Circulate to assist and provide feedback.

Application

- Students will individually record an exercise provided in the resource. They will send their recordings to the teacher for evaluation, allowing for adaptation based on the students' progress.
- o The teacher can repeat the resource as needed.
- Students will record themselves describing the after-school activities they have been involved in, send the recordings to the teacher for evaluation.
- o They will use the dialogue and their group discussions as references.
- The teacher may adapt the activity based on students' progress, allowing for additional recordings or introducing new evaluation tasks.
